Disclaimer. (Signature required before participation in any sailing activity.)

Although Dinghy Sailing is a very safe sport, anything that involves water does have an element of risk. The sailing club insists that all members and visitors wear a buoyancy aid on and around the jetties and whilst on the water. The only other recognised risk of injury is from the boom. This can swing across suddenly and may be painful if the sailor does not duck below it. Most forms of head protection are not ideal for sailing as they either restrict the feel of the wind or may not even cover the area of the head at risk. For this reason the sport encourages education and care rather than relying upon the assumption that a helmet will keep one safe.

South Staffordshire Sailing Club its officers and members and RYA/NSSA Instructors, NSSA Sailing Masters, RYA Senior Instructors or RYA Coaches do not accept responsibility for any loss, damage or injury suffered by persons and / or their property arising out of or during the course of their activities whilst training and / or coaching and / or instructing unless such injury loss or damage was caused by, or resulted from negligence or deliberate act.

I understand that the club is only able to provide safety boat facilities during the hours of club racing and training, outside these hours the club cannot be expected to exercise supervision or control.

I understand that during club activities the club cannot accept responsibility for other juniors or any other persons not engaged in aforementioned sailing activity.

The decision to allow my child to participate in any sailing activity is my sole responsibility. I accept responsibility for his/her conduct whilst participating in the above sailing activity and at all other times whilst on the club premises. I undertake to ensure that he/she will attend junior sailing activities suitably clothed and presented.

I accept responsibility for the seaworthiness of my child's dinghy and for its adequate insurance against third party claims (to the sum of at least £2 million)
